# **MODERNIZING THE STATE HEALTH CENTER SYSTEM**

## I. INTRODUCTION

This document provides an overview of the Department's plan to modernize the State Health Center system and describes how the plan will be implemented. In brief, the plan calls for consolidating 26 of 60 State Health Centers (SHCs) in neighboring counties to improve the delivery of public health services to county residents by mobilizing Department personnel into the community. There will be no decrease in the public health services provided to residents in those counties where a SHC has been consolidated with and relocated to a SHC in a neighboring county. The modernization plan is designed to *increase* county residents' access to public health services in the communities where they live and work. In addition, county residents will not have to leave their county for public health services unless they choose to do so.

The Department has the statutory duty to protect the health of Pennsylvanians and to determine and employ the most efficient and practical means for the prevention and suppression of disease. 71 P.S. §§ 532(a) and 1403(a). The Disease Prevention and Control Law (35 P.S. §§ 521.1 *et seq.*) specifically gives the Department the responsibility for the prevention and control of communicable and non-communicable disease in any municipality that is not served by a local board or department of health, including disease control in public and private schools. The Department's Bureau of Community Health Systems (Bureau) implements the Department's public health programs, in part, through a network of District Offices and SHCs.

Over the years, the Department has continually reviewed its mission and sought ways to update its delivery of public health services as necessitated by changes in the overall health care system. But the Department's public health services have remained constant and offer direct patient care in the following areas:

- TB – diagnosis, treatment, contact tracing and related patient education services for tuberculosis;
- STDs – diagnosis, treatment, partner tracing, notification and testing, and related patient education services for sexually transmitted diseases;
- HIV – testing, counseling, treatment referral and partner services, including notification and testing, and related patient education services for human immunodeficiency virus; and
- Immunization – for children and some adults.

Immunization and disease testing services, in particular, are public health services in which the Department is the provider of last resort, or where there are no appropriate local organizations to handle such issues.

The reality of present day public health is that funding sources are limited at the federal and state level—the result of which is that the Department has experienced a steady decline in the number of allocated and budgeted positions in the Bureau over the last several years. Significantly, however, loss of state and federal funding has never interfered with the

Department's commitment to provide public health services in the most efficient and practical means available.

## II. BACKGROUND: ECONOMIC AND BUDGETARY ISSUES

The downturn in the economy and the obligation of the Commonwealth to operate a balanced budget, while still providing necessary services for the citizens of Pennsylvania, have resulted in funding decreases to many government entities, including the Department. Appropriation 10-471, which provides for the operation of the SHCs, continues to experience decreased funding levels. For example, the State Health Care Centers appropriation decreased from \$24,198,000 in SFY 2007-2008 to \$20,753,000 in SFY 2012-2013, constituting a reduction of more than 16 percent in a six-year period. During this same period, personnel and operational costs have essentially remained level, due to vacancies not being filled. Steps taken to balance the Bureau's budget have resulted in the loss of 37 vacant full-time Community Health Nurse positions from 2008 through March 2013.

The Bureau's SFY 2012-2013 budget includes personnel costs that account for \$17.9 million, and operating costs that account for \$2.8 million. Seventy-seven percent of operating costs of the District Offices and SHCs are alone tied directly to leases. The remaining operational budget, which includes travel, office supplies, telephone, data equipment and other costs, relies on almost \$860,000 in federal grant monies from other Department Bureaus. Any monies that pay operational costs are monies that are not available to provide public health services.

When allocating funding, the Bureau's priority has been to maintain an appropriate complement level to ensure public health services are provided in each of the 60 SHCs. In 2007, the Bureau's approved complement was 304. In 2012, the approved complement was 258. The reduction of 46 positions over this five-year period represents a loss of 18 percent of the Bureau's work force. The impact of this reduction has been a decrease of staffing in the District Offices and SHCs. The following breakdown illustrates the loss of these positions:

- Eight SHCs are staffed by only one nurse;
- Four SHCs have two nurses and no clerk typist;
- Eighteen SHCs are staffed by one nurse and one clerk typist; and
- The remaining thirty SHCs are staffed by more than one nurse and one clerk typist.

Nevertheless, the Department has maintained the level of public health services provided by the Community Health Nurses assigned to the State Health Centers. There are currently 94 Community Health Nurse positions assigned to SHCs. Maintaining the leases of all 60 SHCs as is, however, in the face of expected funding decreases in the future, will necessarily mean the loss of even more SHC nurses and staff. The Department evaluated how the SHNs provide public health services to their clients to determine the most efficient and practical means of providing those services. Modernization of public health service delivery will enable the Department to maintain the SHC nurse positions and not risk compromising public health service delivery.

### III. STATE HEALTH CENTERS AND PUBLIC HEALTH TODAY

Community Health Nurses in the SHCs are responsible for providing direct public health services to citizens through counseling, teaching, home visits, and clinical services. These nurses-in-the-field provide a referral service to other official and volunteer agencies, act as a one-stop information center for all public health programs offered by the Department, and utilize a variety of resources and mechanisms to promote public health education. The SHC nurses coordinate activities of local health jurisdictions in the county, participate in cooperative community health related projects, and serve in an advocacy role for citizens needing health care. They conduct epidemiological investigations, provide immunization services and testing for some diseases and conditions, and provide partner-related services (notification, counseling and testing) for certain specific diseases and conditions in coordination with the District Offices and the Department's Central Office (Harrisburg). The provision of these services will continue under the modernization plan but will be more responsive to the evolution of community public health needs.

In contrast to the SHC nurses, Community Health Nurses in the District Offices do not provide direct public health services to citizens (except in a public health emergency), but rather provide consultative services to the nurses in the SHCs. Community Health Nurse positions in the District Offices supplement the expertise of field Community Health Nurses and provide technical expertise about specific programs, depending on the needs in a particular county or district. These services are not unique, and the Department discovered that certain services and functions provided by the SHCs, as well as by the Community Health Nurse Consultants, overlapped with existing services that were more effectively provided directly by the Department's Bureaus and Divisions, including the Bureau of Epidemiology, Bureau of Communicable Diseases, and Bureau of Public Health Preparedness.

The modernization plan seeks to end a duplication of consultative services by eliminating some Community Health Nurse positions in the District Offices. Some clerical staff positions in the SHCs slated for consolidation will be eliminated, but those clerical duties and functions will be assumed by clerical staff in the District Offices or in the consolidated SHCs, as needed. Significantly, however, *all* Community Health Nurse positions assigned to SHCs will be *retained* even though some SHCs will be consolidated and relocated in neighboring counties.

Public health today is much different from what it was 20 years ago. The patterns of service delivery that existed historically in the SHCs that served these counties have necessarily evolved over time, adapting to the needs of and resources in their respective locations. Changes in funding, technology, and in the provision of clinical, population-based and community-based services have influenced the delivery of public health services. Changes in the distribution of federal vaccine supplies to states, changes in population groups to which vaccines provided by the federal government can be administered, changes in eligibility for such public benefit programs as Medicaid that may have caused a migration of some previously uninsured clients into care provided by private physicians, have resulted in the reduction of some services once provided in the SHCs. These factors are, of course, outside the Department's control.

#### IV. MODERNIZATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE DELIVERY

As noted above, modernization includes co-locating 26 of the 60 SHC buildings, while at the same time providing public health services at regularly scheduled clinics at community sites throughout the counties to benefit the underserved populations that need those services the most. By modernizing the SHC system, the Department will continue to have a physical presence in the counties through a more mobile and visible staff of nurses who will bring the Department's public health services to people in the communities where they live and work. All public health services will continue in designated locations in all of the counties where a "brick and mortar" health center existed in 1995.

Because of the nature of the Department's public health services, much of the work of the SHC Community Health Nurses today already takes place off-site in the community, not at the center itself. Public health has embraced the importance of local grass roots organizations that are committed to addressing the key health issues (primary and public) of their localities. Over the years, the Department has formed relationships with these organizations to provide public health services in their own communities to promote wellness and prevent injury and disease.

Indeed, the Department and SHC Community Health Nurses are already providing public health services to Pennsylvanians at fire halls, churches, senior centers, and schools, in conjunction with our community partners. SHC Community Health Nurses are already doing what the Department's modernization plan calls for on a much larger scale. Community Health Nurses assess a community's need, identify what underserved population is not coming to a SHC and why, and determine where and how to reach the underserved in a way that is convenient for them. Regardless of what type of off-site clinic is planned, these nurses have developed relationships with community leaders and already know what facilities in their communities offer the necessary convenience and privacy the Department recognizes is paramount. Under the Department's modernization plan, the Community Health Nurses will no longer be tethered to "brick and mortar" facilities that too few people visit, but will be out in their communities bringing vital public health services more efficiently and effectively to more people.

Potter County offers an example of how the modernization plan will work. The SHC in Potter County has not had a SHC nurse for approximately six to eight months, yet public health services are being provided to Potter County residents by the SHC nurse from Tioga County. The Tioga County SHC nurse routinely holds clinics in different communities in Potter County, including at a fire hall in Ulysses, the county prison in Coudersport, a drug store in Galeton, and the Potter County Human Services Agency in Roulette, while also conducting clinics in Tioga County. The Tioga County SHC nurse has also held a clinic at a Potter County construction company at the company's request.

Sullivan County is another example of why a *building* is no measure of the effective delivery of public health services. A SHC has never been located in Sullivan County, but public health services are being provided to Sullivan County residents by SHC nurses from neighboring counties. That will continue under the Department's modernization plan.

The Bureau has provided—and will continue to provide—the nurses in the field with coolers and thermometers to ensure proper vaccine storage; all nurses have access to cell phones, are reimbursed for travel expenses, or have access to a rental or office vehicle. Going forward, the Department will ensure that laptops are provided to nurses who want them. Telephone calls to the SHC slated for consolidation will be re-routed to the District Offices or the consolidated SHCs. While appointments for clinics will be handled and scheduled in the same way, Community Health Nurses will continue to work closely with community, business, and legislative leaders to establish clinic locations, times, and dates. Community Health Nurses will also be able to publicize the time, date, and place of off-site clinics in the community through press releases, flyers, and posters. Finally, the Department is updating its website to include SHC and clinic information across the Commonwealth. Individuals accessing the site will be able to view a list of events in their area including locations, times, and dates, as well as information on the public health services provided.

## V. CONCLUSION

Co-locating or consolidating SHCs will reduce leasing costs and better allocate personnel to provide a more comprehensive public health infrastructure and operate more efficiently in all counties. More staff will provide services to multiple counties from a single location. With today's technology, communicable disease investigations, animal bites and other work can be completed electronically or by telephone. Modernizing the SHC system will not only improve the Bureau's efficiencies; it will also enable the Bureau to be more mobile, increase Department visibility in communities by specifically targeting those underserved populations, and address Pennsylvania's public health needs of the 21st century.

Attachment A is a map showing the current configuration of the Department's Community Health Districts, including District Offices and SHCs, as well as municipal and county health departments. Attachment B is a map showing the configuration of the Department's Community Health Districts under the modernization plan once implemented. Attachment C provides a county-by-county glimpse of public health services currently offered, examples of current community outreach efforts, and examples of future community outreach efforts. As is evident in Attachment C, the delivery of public health services will only increase as Community Health Nurses leave the "brick and mortar" facilities and go out into their communities to serve their constituents.

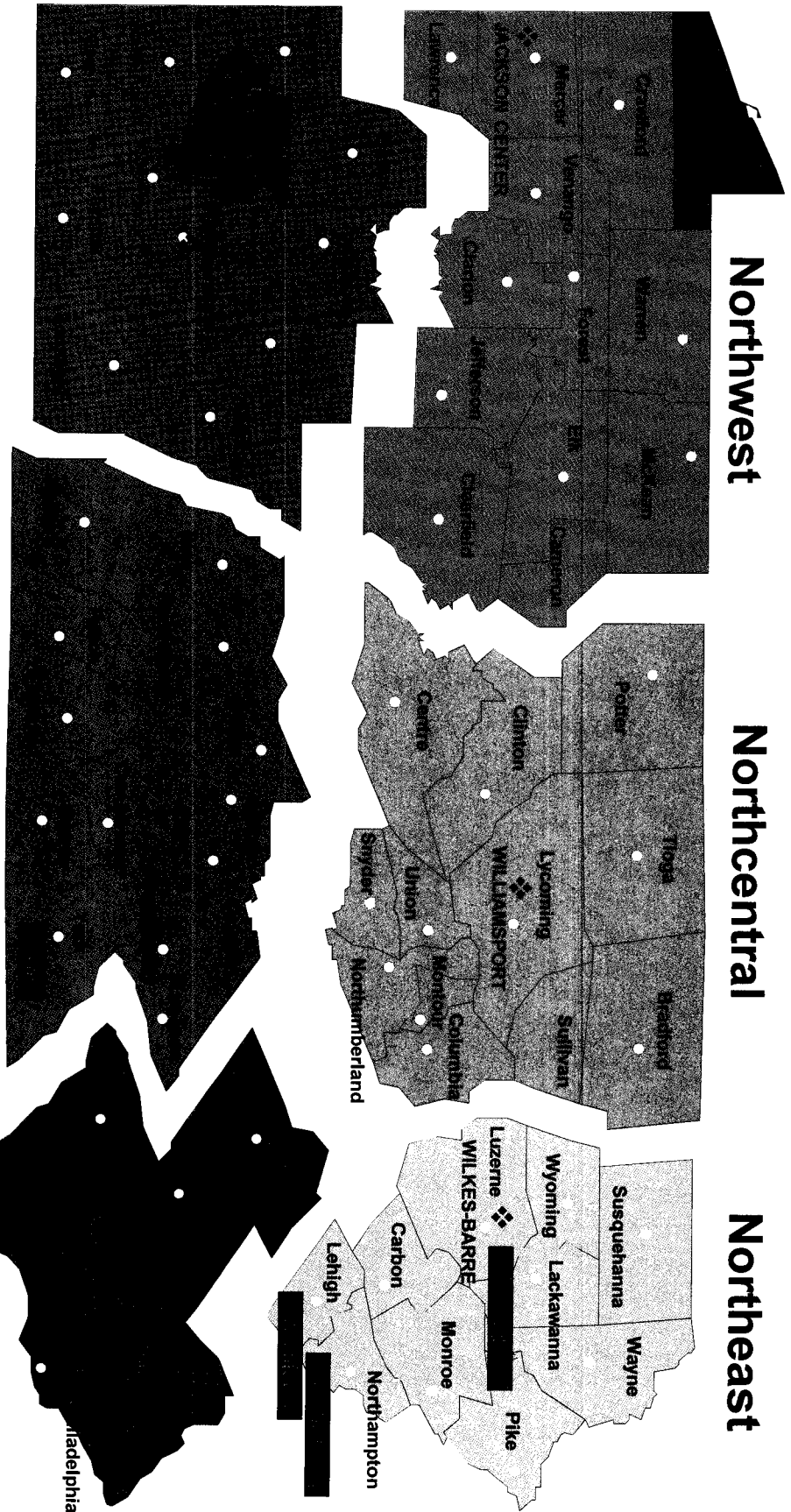

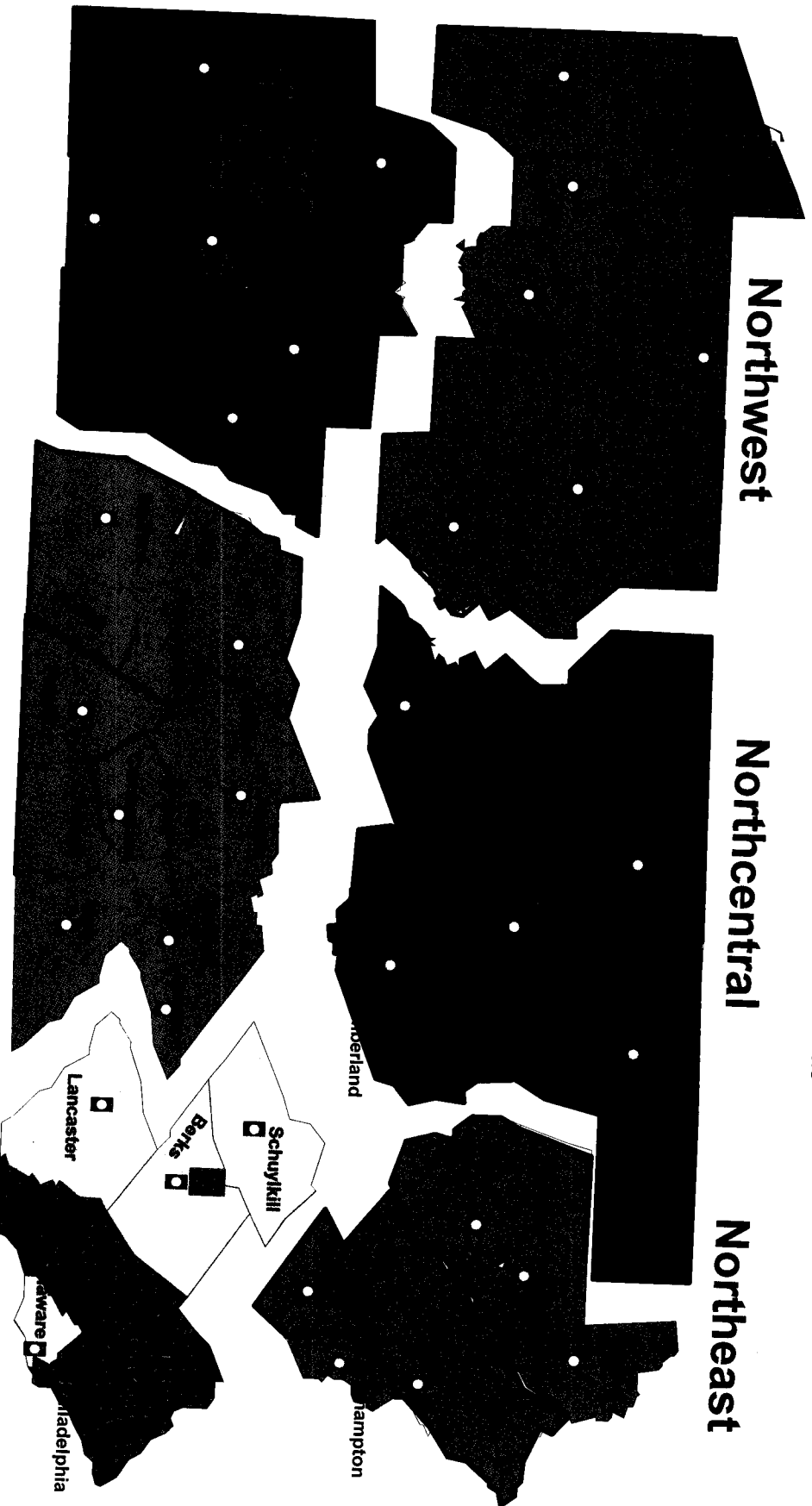
