22 (1) Immediately ensure the safety of the child and see  
23 the child immediately if emergency protective custody is  
24 required or has been or shall be taken or if it cannot be  
25 determined from the report whether emergency protective  
26 custody is needed.

27 (2) Physically see the child within 48 hours of receipt

1 of the report.

2 (3) Contact the parents of the child within 24 hours of  
3 receipt of the report.

4 (4) Provide or arrange reasonable services to ensure the  
5 child is provided with proper parental care, control and  
6 supervision.
