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Summary SR 70 PN 789

This resolution directs the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee (LB & FC) to study the issue of specialty tier prescription drug pricing and its impact on patient care and access to medications.

Historically, specialty drugs have been placed on a fourth or greater drug tier by prescription drug benefit plans. The effect is that the cost to consumers is greater than if the drug were placed on a lower tier.

Some of the conditions treated with specialty drugs are: hemophilia, multiple sclerosis, lupus, some cancers and rheumatoid arthritis. The number of these drugs as well as utilization and unit cost is expected to increase.

LB & FC is required to report its findings to the Senate no later than January 30, 2014.
