## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of July 8, 1986 (P.L.408, No.89), entitled, as reenacted, "An act providing for the creation of the Health Care Cost Containment Council, for its powers and duties, for health care cost containment through the collection and dissemination of data, for public accountability of health care costs and for health care for the indigent; and making an appropriation," further providing for expiration of the act.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. Section 19 of the act of July 8, 1986 (P.L.408,
12	No.89), known as the Health Care Cost Containment Act, reenacted
13	and amended June 10, 2009 (P.L.10, No.3), is amended to read:
14	Section 19. [Sunset.] <u>Expiration.</u>
15	This act shall expire June 30, [2014, unless reenacted prior
16	to that date] 2017. By September 1, 2013, a written report by
17	the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee evaluating the
18	management, visibility, awareness and performance of the council
19	shall be provided to the Public Health and Welfare Committee of
20	the Senate and the Health and Human Services Committee of the

House of Representatives. The report shall include a review of the council's procedures and policies, the availability and quality of data for completing reports, whether there is a more cost-efficient way of accomplishing the objectives of the council and the need for reauthorization of the council. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
