4	with this section sounds, the care facility staff shall:
5	(i) Take immediate action to introduce fresh outside
6	air into the care facility by opening available windows
7	and doors, unless opening a specific door presents
8	additional risk to resident safety.
9	(ii) Contact emergency services in accordance with
10	the care facility's written policies and procedures
11	relating to carbon monoxide alarms and evacuations.
12	(iii) Move residents to the nearest source of fresh
13	outside air, account for all residents and remain with
14	the residents until emergency personnel arrive and assess
15	the need for evacuation.
16	(iv) Evacuate residents when emergency personnel
17	consider an evacuation necessary, in accordance with the
18	care facility's fire safety regulatory standards
19	contained in 28 Pa. Code Ch. 209 (relating to fire
20	protection and safety programs for long-term care nursing
21	facilities) and 55 Pa. Code Chs. 2600 (relating to
22	personal care homes) and 2800 (relating to assisted
23	living residences).
24	(2) Nothing in this act shall be construed to require
25	care facilities to conduct drills specific to carbon
26	monoxide.
