

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 118 Printer's No. 244

Prime Sponsor: Kaufer Committee: Health and Human Services

SYNOPSIS:

Amends the Health Care Facilities Act by adding a Section 822 establishing the Emergency Drug and Alcohol Detoxification Program ("EDADP"). The EDADP provides for detoxification in licensed health care facilities.

SUMMARY:

Section 822 establishes the EDADP within the Department of Health ("DOH") for detoxification in licensed health care facilities and for the establishment of detoxification facilities.

The EDADP is mandated to utilize existing beds in health care facilities, to the greatest extent possible.

In order to provide more timely access to drug and alcohol detoxification, the DOH must provide special priority to the review of applications for licensure under the EDADP.

Effective Date: 60 days.
