

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 424 Printer's No. 440

Prime Sponsor: Benninghoff

SYNOPSIS:

Amends the Vital Statistics Law of 1953 (the "Law") by allowing physician assistants to supply and sign medical certifications of death or fetal death.

SUMMARY:

Amends Section 502 of the Law by providing that, except in the event of a referral to a coroner pursuant to Section 503, the medical certification in the event of a death or fetal death may be supplied (and certified by signature) by a physician assistant.

As is currently the case with physicians, certified registered nurse practitioners, and dentists, a physician assistant must refer a case to other specified individuals in the event that the decedent is a member of the immediate family of the physician assistant.

Amends Section 503 by indicating the circumstances under which cases must be referred to a coroner when a physician assistant is unable or unwilling to supply the necessary data or when supplying the data would otherwise be inappropriate. These circumstances are the same as those for a physician, a certified registered nurse practitioner, or a dentist.
