

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 508 Printer's No. 1500

Prime Sponsor: Cox

Committee: Health and Human Services

SYNOPSIS:

Prohibits individuals who are required to register as convicted sexual offenders, but have not done so, from receiving public assistance.

SUMMARY:

Prohibits an individual who is required to register as a convicted sexual offender under 42 Pa. C.S. Section 9799.13, and who is not compliant, from receiving public assistance until the individual complies with applicable registration requirements.

Assistance for minor children living in the household shall not be effected by this prohibition.

The Department is required to issue regulations to effect compliance with the registration requirements for individuals who are homeless or transient.
